Lesson Objective:

- 1. To REVEAL from the Word of God that God has gifted each believer with a Spiritual Gift
- 2. To ENCOURAGE the discovery and exercise of one's Spiritual Gift for the ministry of others.

A. The DEFINITION of Spiritual Gifts

Spiritual gifts are God's special gifts given by grace to believers to enable them to provide special service to the body of Christ and in the world.

1 Peter 4:10 As <u>each one has received</u> a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

2. The Giving of Spiritual Gifts is an act of God's Grace

1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received <u>a gift</u> [charisma], minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace [charis] of God.

3. Spiritual Gifts are for Service to Others

☐ 1 Peter 4:10 As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

4. Spiritual Gifts are Given by the Holy Spirit

☐ 1 Corinthians 12:11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

5. Spiritual Gifts are for the Glory of God

1 Peter 4:11 If anyone speaks, let him speak as the oracles of God. If anyone ministers, let him do it as with the ability which God supplies, that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen. .
