В.	Christ's Instruction on Habitual Prayer:	
	1. The Model – Luke 11:2-4	
	Suggestions for learning from the model:	
	a) Our Father in heaven, – Pray as a in His family.	
	b) Hallowed be Your name. – Pray as an effort to seek God's today.	
	c) Your kingdom come, – Pray in anticipation of glory.	
	d) Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. – Pray recognizing you are in S	

	e)	Give us this day our daily bread. – Pray for physical needs, recognizing how little control over your own life you truly have.
	f)	And forgive us our sins, For we also forgive everyone who is indebted to us. – Pray for closer as you are seeking restoration of all relationships.
	g)	And do not lead us into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one. – Pray for in resisting temptation to sin.
