## Reminder:

A God of grace doesn't need you to be great (1 Corinthians 1:18-31)

- \* The message of the cross does not make sense to those who can't understand grace, yet grace is powerful. (1 Cor. 1:18-25)
- \* Those who have been saved by grace must not forget what grace reveals about themselves and about God. (1 Cor. 1:26-31)
