***Prelude to the Cross – Via Dolorosa*** (Luke 23:26-33, Matt. 27:32-34, Mark 15:21-23, John 19:16-18)

**1) “Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do.”**

Luke 23:34

Isaiah 53:3-10

- <sup>3</sup> He is despised and rejected by men, a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.  
And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.
- <sup>4</sup> Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows;  
Yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.
- <sup>5</sup> But He *was* wounded for our transgressions, *He was* bruised for our iniquities;  
The chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.
- <sup>6</sup> All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way;  
And the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- <sup>7</sup> He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth;  
He was led as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before its shearers is silent,  
So He opened not His mouth.
- <sup>8</sup> He was taken from prison and from judgment, and who will declare His generation?  
For He was cut off from the land of the living;  
For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.
- <sup>9</sup> And they made His grave with the wicked—but with the rich at His death,  
Because He had done no violence, nor *was any* deceit in His mouth.
- <sup>10</sup> Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put *Him* to grief.  
When You make His soul an offering for sin,  
He shall see *His* seed, He shall prolong *His* days,  
And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.
