Moses, the Friend of God:

God Called an Unlikely Servant

A. God says He is about to do big things. (Ex. 3:1-9)

The bush foreshadows the sort of vessel God requires. (v1-4)

Both God and Moses acknowledge that Moses is unworthy of the voice in the bush. (v5-6)

God says He is ready to deliver the Hebrews (v7-9)

B. Moses will tag along. (Ex. 3:10-12)

"I will send you" (v10)

"Who am I?" (v11)

"I will certainly be with you" (v12)
