

Moses, the Friend of God:

# Disappointment and Prayer

## **A. This is harder than I thought it would be.** (Exodus 5:1-23)

*5:1 – Moses and Aaron deliver the message.*

*5:2-5 – Predictably, Pharaoh refused.*

*5:6-19 – Things got worse for the Hebrews.*

*5:20-21 – “It’s your fault, Moses!”*

*5:22-23 – “Why, Lord?”*

## **B. The LORD is not worried, but I am still worried.** (Exodus 6:1-7:7)

*6:1 – The LORD, not Moses, will take care of Pharaoh.*

*6:2-8 – Moses has his focus centered on the identity of his God.*

*6:9 – Moses was ready to move ahead, but the Hebrew people were too dejected.*

*6:10-13 – The LORD urges Moses and Aaron to go on, with or without the support of others.*

*6:14-27 – Who are Moses and Aaron?*

*6:28-7:7 – The LORD will establish His reputation.*
