Moses, the Friend of God:

Mountain-Climbing Mediator

A. Back and Forth (Exodus 19:1-25)

v1-2 – How long did it take them to get to Mount Sinai?

Hike #1

- v3-4 God tells Moses to remind the people what He has done for them.
- **v5-6** God tells Moses to invite the people into a conditional covenant.
- v7-8a Moses delivers the message and the people accept the terms.

Hike #2

- **v8b** Moses brings back the answer of the people.
- v9a God tells Moses how the people are going to hear the covenant
- **v9b** Moses delivers the message to the people.

Hike #3

- v10-13 God gives Moses instructions for consecration.
- v14-15 Moses delivers the instructions to the people to sanctify them.

Hike #4

- v16-18 God initiates the meeting between Him and the people with a fireworks show.
- v19 The people hear God's voice.
- **v20** Moses and God meet at the top of the mountain.
- **v21-22** God tells Moses to give the people an additional warning.
- **v23-24 –** Moses protests but loses the argument.
- **v25** Moses delivers the additional warning to the people.

B. Hearing and Fearing (Exodus 20:1-21)
v1-17 – God speaks the Ten Commandments
v18-19 – The people were afraid of the fireworks and of the voice of God.
v20 – Moses encourages the people with a purpose in the fear of God.
V20 - Moses encodinges the people with a purpose in the lear of Cod.
11:1 ₁₋₂ #EQ
Hike #5?
v21 – The people stand back, and Moses goes back up the mountain to God to serve as mediator.
