To Be Humble: means to choose to bring yourself to a low position, in order to benefit someone else.

Humble by coming to a place well below His standards (John 1:14, 2Cor. 8:9)

Humble by whom He was friends with (Matthew 9:10-11)

- Are you too good to talk to _____?

Humbled Himself in His death (John 10:18)

- Are you too do to do what God what’s you to do?

To Be Obedient: means to do the will of another no matter what.

He obeyed His earthly Parents as a child (Luke 2:51)

- Kids do you obey your parents? (Ephesians 6:1)
- Parents do you obey your boss at work? (Ephesians 6:5)

He obeyed His heavenly Father as an Adult (Matthew 26:38-39, Phil. 2:8c)

- Mom’s and Dad’s do you obey God’s will for your life
 - This is the will of God...

To Be a Servant: means meeting the needs of another, by the Grace of God, because of the will of God.

He served His disciples by washing their feet (John 13:1-17)

- Where has God called you to minister?

He served the whole world by giving His life for everyone (Matthew 20:28)
