**9. The \_\_\_\_\_ of Joab (14:1-3)**

- a. So Joab devised a plan by using a \_\_\_\_\_ woman from Tekoa to go before David with a \_\_\_\_\_ that Joab made up & had put into her \_\_\_\_\_ to get David's \_\_\_\_\_ to protect the widow's only \_\_\_\_\_!

- Where have we seen this approach before?

**b. The \_\_\_\_\_ by the woman of Tekoa (14:4-7)**

- What would be the basis for the family requesting to avenge this death?

- a. But this crafty woman wisely lays before David that this would “\_\_\_\_\_ *my only* \_\_\_\_\_ *that is left,*” meaning she would be without \_\_\_\_\_ by a man, as well as, there would be no \_\_\_\_\_ to carry on the name of her husband in Israel.
