### Knowing Your Position

Romans 6:1-14

I. THE VICTORY OVER SIN'S POWER IN YOUR LIFE IS FOUND IN \_\_\_\_\_ AND \_\_\_\_\_ ON YOUR POSITION IN CHRIST.

A. The Logical Question Raised (6:1) "... *shall we continue in sin that grace may abound?*"

1. "then" points you back to \_\_\_\_\_ !

B. An Emphatic Answer is Given (6:2a)

C. A Theological /Doctrinal Reason for the Answer as Stated: "*How shall we that \_\_\_\_\_ live any longer in sin*" (6:2b)

#### **F. Personal Applications Made for the New Life (6:11-13)**

1. Reckon yourself to be \_\_\_\_\_ indeed to sin (6:11)
2. Do not let the sin nature \_\_\_\_\_ as a king in your life (6:12)
3. Stop presenting yourself as an \_\_\_\_\_ for the sin nature’s use and start presenting yourself to God for \_\_\_\_\_ sake! (6:13)

#### **G. The Summary of All This (6:14)**

1. In sanctification, God never intended the sin nature to have \_\_\_\_\_ over you, for Christ’s death has \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ you from sin’s power!
2. As in justification, you are not now under \_\_\_\_\_ (to live the Christian life), but under \_\_\_\_\_.
