

**JOSEPH REVEALS HIMSELF TO HIS BROTHERS**  
(Genesis 45:16-28)

**A. One More Test to Pass (Genesis 44-45:15)**

1. Joseph emotionally bursts out to his brothers in their own Hebrew tongue, “**I Am \_\_\_\_\_, does my father \_\_\_\_\_**”? (45:1-4)
  
2. The revelation of his \_\_\_\_\_ which included: (45:5-15)
