**I. ENJOYING GOD'S PEACE WITH REGARD TO THINGS (Phil 4:10-12)**

**A. Paul Rejoiced Concerning Their \_\_\_\_\_ Which Came To Him At Rome (4:10)**

1. Paul rejoiced \_\_\_\_\_ greatly!
2. Paul rejoiced concerning the \_\_\_\_\_ this church had sent him by the hand of Epaphroditus.

- What's our *obligation* in regards to *giving*? (1 Cor. 9:5-15)
