**THE CONFUSION ABOUT SALVATION**

*B. What are some WRONG CONDITIONS For Salvation?*

The confusion: "Believe and be Baptized"

\* Who believes in "baptismal regeneration" today?

The clarification: Water baptism is a \_\_\_\_\_ of  
salvation for believers, not a means of salvation for unbelievers. (Acts 8:26-40; Acts  
10:43-48)

\* Why is it significant that John doesn't command baptism? (John 20:31)

The confusion: "Believe and keep the 10 commandments"

\* Is this a common belief today?

The clarification: Though the Law can show us that we are sinners, it cannot  
\_\_\_\_\_ us from our sins. (Romans 3:19-20; Galatians 3:24-25)

\* What is the purpose of the law?

The confusion: “Believe and confess your sins”

\* Who teaches that unbelievers must confess their sins to be saved?

The clarification: Confession of known sin is necessary for the believer to be restored to \_\_\_\_\_ with God, not for salvation from Hell. (1 John 1:3-10)

\* Is sin the problem between an unbeliever and God? (John 3:18)

The confusion: “Repent of your sins and be saved”

\* Is this a common teaching today?

The clarification: Since your sins have been paid for by Jesus Christ, you need to \_\_\_\_\_ (repent) about trusting anything but Jesus Christ to save you. (Acts 17:30-34)

\* How many times does the Bible command unbelievers to “repent of sin to be saved?”

The confusion: “Ask (or invite) Jesus into your heart (or life)”

\* Who uses this wrong response today?

The clarification: Jesus Christ comes into your heart when you put your \_\_\_\_\_, not as a result of asking Him in. (John 1:12; Galatians 2:20; 4:6)

\* What about Revelation 3:20?
