### III. THE CONFUSION ABOUT SALVATION

#### A. What Are Some WRONG CONDITIONS For Salvation?

1. The confusion: “Believe and Be Baptized”

The clarification: Water baptism is a \_\_\_\_\_ of salvation for believers, not a means of salvation for unbelievers. (Acts 8:26-40; Acts 10:43-48)

2. The confusion: “Believe and keep the 10 Commandments”

The clarification: Though the Law can show us that we are sinners, it cannot \_\_\_\_\_ us from our sins. (Romans 3:19-20; Gal. 3:24-25)

3. The confusion: “Believe and confess your sins”

The clarification: Confession of sin is required for the believer to be restored to \_\_\_\_\_ with God, not for salvation from Hell. (1 John 1:3-10)

4. The confusion: “Repent of your sins and be saved”

The clarification: Since your sins have been paid for by Jesus Christ, you need to \_\_\_\_\_ (repent) about trusting anything but Jesus Christ to save you. (Acts 17-34)

5. The confusion: “Ask Jesus into your heart or life”

The clarification: Jesus Christ comes into your heart when you \_\_\_\_\_, not as a result of asking Him in. (John 1:12; Gal. 4:6; Gal. 2:20)

6. The confusion: “Make Christ Lord of your life”

The clarification: Since Christ is Lord (God), salvation comes by simply trusting in Him, \_\_\_\_\_  
\_\_\_\_\_. (Romans 12:1-2)

7. The confusion: “Believe and live a holy life”

The clarification: While every believer should live a holy life, this should be the \_\_\_\_\_  
of salvation; it is not the means of obtaining or maintaining it.

8. The confusion: “Come forward and pray the sinner’s prayer”

The clarification: This is \_\_\_\_\_ found in the Bible as the issue is not coming  
forward but \_\_\_\_\_. (John 6:37-40)
