**\*Some examples of this today:**

- 8) \_\_\_\_\_ and confusion: the human wisdom that \_\_\_\_\_ and the destruction of biblical \_\_\_\_\_. (Gen.1:26-27; Ephesians 5:22-25)
- 9) \_\_\_\_\_: the human wisdom that promotes religious \_\_\_\_\_ apart from biblical \_\_\_\_\_ and the foundation of the \_\_\_\_\_ as if all roads lead to God, while practicing the \_\_\_\_\_ justifies the \_\_\_\_\_. (2 Corinthians 6:14-18)
