**E. GOD’S PROVISIONS For Every Believer in Christ. (8:31-34)** - To underscore the means and magnitude of God’s provision for our eternal security and future glorification, Paul raises the following questions:

#1: “What then shall we say to these things {in reference to vs.18-30}?” (8:31a)

**\*For Whom Did Christ Die? - Jesus Christ died ...**

- 1) For \_\_\_\_\_ – 1 Tim. 2:6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time. Isaiah 53:6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned everyone to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- 2) For \_\_\_\_\_ – Hebrews 2:9 But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man.
- 3) For \_\_\_\_\_ – John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
- 4) For the \_\_\_\_\_ – 1 John 2:2 And He is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.
- 5) For the \_\_\_\_\_ – Romans 5:6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- 6) For \_\_\_\_\_ – 2 Peter 2:1 But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who secretly shall bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.
- 7) For \_\_\_\_\_ – Matthew 20:28 Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.
- 8) For \_\_\_\_\_ – John 11:50-51 Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish not. And this spoke he not of himself: but being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus should die for that nation.
- 9) For \_\_\_\_\_ – Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave Himself for it.
- 10) For \_\_\_\_\_ – Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me.
